

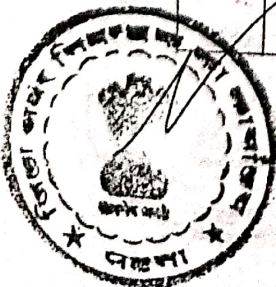

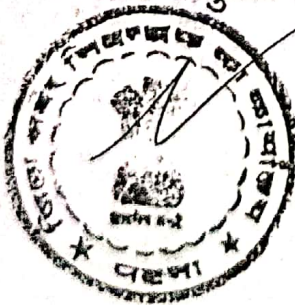
And whereas the trustees have, at the request of the settler, agreed to act as the first trustees of these presents as testified their being parties to and executing these presents.
